Solutions to Emerging Problems

As companies collect and use an increasing amount of sensitive information, the risk of data breaches and mishandled information has grown significantly. In fact, this year, privacy executives ranked employees' inappropriate use of personal and confidential information as their top privacy-related risk.

Our research finds that the majority of privacy failures are unintentional and more than 72% are repeated, suggesting a breakdown in internal privacy controls. Privacy failures disproportionately result from poor process design and human error—either from lack of employee awareness or employee mistakes.

To reduce this risk, privacy departments need to adjust how they design and test internal processes and focus training on reinforcing desired privacy compliance behaviors.

This year, we will focus on helping heads of Privacy do the following:

- Develop an integrated framework for designing privacy controls and routinely updating procedures based on observed failure points
- Improve employee privacy compliance and awareness through training and communications designed to reinforce appropriate behaviors
- Evaluate the effectiveness of privacy efforts through objective measures and prioritize areas of focus


