| “GET READY to click with a site that clicks with you” flyer: Give your employees an overview of what they can look forward to on the new site. | After April 1 |
| “CONNECT with myCigna” ecard: A quicker, shorter email version of the overview flyer. Send this out along with the overview flyer, or separately for additional communications. | After April 1 |
| “A BETTER SITE is in your sights” Reminder ecard: When the launch gets closer, use this ecard to remind your employees that the new site is almost here. | After May 1 |
| “We have Lift off” Launch ecard: Send this out to let your employees know that myCigna.com is launched. | When the new site launches |
