1. Connection of power cord and pressing power - On/Off switch	
2. Purpose and operation of each front panel control (e.g., control buttons/knob, alarm silence, pump off, etc.)	
3. Understanding of monitor display (e.g., etCO ₂ , RR, waveform, etc.)	
4. Navigation of the monitor's menu screens to perform operational functions including:	
- Home Screen / etCO ₂ / SpO ₂ (as applicable) Setup	
- System Screen (e.g., clear trend, D/A Setup, Cal Check, etc.) including use of password to enter	
- Service Screen (e.g., institutional defaults, software support, CO ₂ calibration, etc.)	
- Alarm Limits Screen (e.g., set alarm limits, set caution enable/disable, default reset, trend screen, etc.)	
- Print functions and printer paper replacement (as applicable)	
- Adjusting alarm and pulse volumes	
5. Proper use of sampling lines and sensors (as applicable) including:	
- Attachment to monitor and application to patient	
- Understanding of single patient use sampling lines and sensors (as applicable)	
- Importance of not attempting to clear a blocked sampling line
