

Overview

Due to the economic slowdown, China's industrial lubricant demand was in a downtrend compared with the same period last year. However, the country's apparent lubricant consumption in the first six months of 2014 was boosted by increased automobile output and sales (which rose by 9.4% and 9% year on year, respectively).

China's base oils production in the first half of 2014 was basically unchanged from the same period in 2013, supported by full operation at Panjin Northern Asphalt's 400,000 tonne/year Group II base oils unit, although major base oils plants have been running at low rates.

As international base oil producers and traders enter 2015, uncertainty surrounds both the short- and long-term outlook for base oils, particularly those in Group II.
