


## HOW THE 340B DISCOUNT APPLIES IN THE HOSPITAL SETTING





1. The 340B patient definition requires that the hospital has established a relationship with the individual such that the hospital maintains records of the individual's health care; and the individual receives health care services from a health care professional who is either employed by the hospital or provides health care under contractual or other arrangements (e.g., referral for consultation) such that responsibility for the care provided remains with the hospital.
