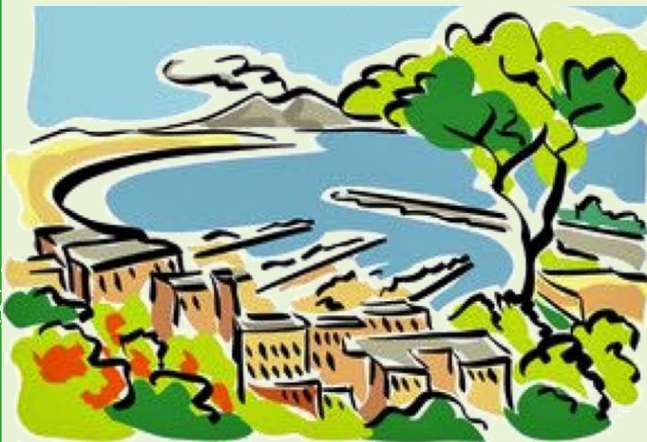

# COMMUNITY MANAGER

## REMINDERS FOR ESTABLISHED AND NEW OWNERS

- ◇ All house guests must be registered with the HOA office 48 hours in advance.
- ◇ Guests 18 years of age and older must sign a fitness waiver release form.
- ◇ Guests 12 years of age and older are required to wear a visitor's guest badge.
- ◇ Residents are permitted to bring up to 6 non-family house guests to the Amenities Center at a time.
- ◇ Access to the amenity center requires a key fob: do not prop the doors or gates open to allow free access.
- ◇ Guests in the pool area: no food or drink is permitted on the wet deck or within 4 feet of the pool's edge, no running on pool deck, no jumping or diving into the pool, children 15 and under are not permitted without resident homeowner, no portable use of electronic devices without headphones, the pool deck and pool may not be reserved for private parties, enter or exit through the pool gates only (no wet suits inside the club house), no rafts, inner tubes or frisbees allowed, no glass is permitted within the pool or spa area.
- ◇ Guests in the spa area: do not force the spa timer off – it will damage the timer, children 12 and under are not permitted in the hot tub, children 13 – 15 permitted with adult supervision, all additional posted pool and spa rules apply.
- ◇ Smoking and vaping are not permitted inside the fenced pool and spa area.
- ◇ Guests at the sports courts: all guests must be accompanied by a resident, children under 17 must be accompanied by a resident, food and drink is not permitted on the courts, anything with wheels is not permitted on the courts.
- ◇ Guests and the Fitness Center: no food at any time is permitted, only bottled water is permitted, guests must be accompanied by a resident, proper attire is required, children 13 – 17 are not permitted without a resident, children under 12 are not permitted, residents may only bring 2 guests at a time to the fitness center, no portable use of electronic devices without headphones.

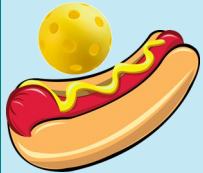
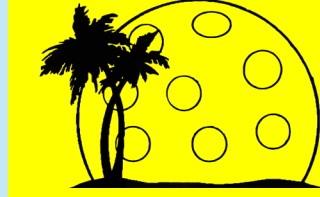

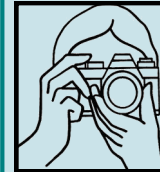
