

There are three versions available: The Lite version offers the basics for the automated creation of organizational charts whereas the Professional version comes with sophisticated controlling features. Simulations and reorganizations can be performed using the Enterprise version.




Lite version

Ingentis org.manager Lite covers the essential requirements for the automated creation of organizational charts. Data is imported automatically via the interface, e.g. SAP, LDAP, CSV, Excel or SQL. The content and design of your org charts can be configured via admin interface. The ingenious box designer gives you space for your ideas! The visualization of photos is also possible. Two display options are included - the most popular are the local desktop viewer and browser based output. Print and search functionalities are supported as well.

Professional version

Based on the Lite version, the Professional version comes with comprehensive features for data manipulations and conditional formatting. This way objects can e.g. be colored or hidden, icons can be used instead of values or relations can be manipulated. The integrated calculation feature enables the calculation of nearly any KPI. Your graphical HR controlling can easily be integrated in your org charts. Various graph types enable an appealing presentation of key performance indicators such as capacity utilization, budget plans, etc. in a personalized and informative way. Extended export functions (image, excel), the configuration of the org chart layout (e.g. tree, feather) as well as extensive print and search functions are part of the Professional version.



The Ingentis org.manager Enterprise contains all features of the Professional version. Besides, the Enterprise version provides you with the org.simulator a useful tool for simulations. The org. simulator allows you to simulate multiple plan versions and scenarios. From restructurings via drag-and-drop to the creation and removal of departments, individual employees or vacancies, to editing more specific information, simulations can be created in a powerful and user-friendly

manner. Simulations can be created directly in a browser – independent from platforms and without installation efforts. The data from the core HR system will not be changed at any time. The simulated data can be compared with any other stock of your HR system and exported to be used in your HR system to reflect the new org structure.
