The French are not the only nation to bring their best exports to the CV Show. At stand 5F40 you can locate Isuzu. The Japanese truck company has brought samples of its offerings, which range from 3.5-tonnes to 11-tonnes vehicles.

Top secret stat Stay out of the courts: Between March 2012 and 2013, 57 per cent of the 39,676 tyres removed by Micheldever Tyre Services had illegal tread depths.

Picking the perfect tyre is key to the success of any transport operation. Tyres are the only part of a van or truck to make contact with road surface, so they have a major bearing on safety as well as affecting fuel efficiency.

An illegal or defective commercial vehicle tyre could mean authorities come down on you like a ton of bricks and punishment can escalate like Cold War tensions. A driver caught behind the wheel of a vehicle with illegal tyres will be hit with three penalty points and a fine of up to £2,500 per tyre, meaning 18-wheelers can be particularly pricey!

Remember to think about overall investment and it doesn't take an MI6 intelligence agent to work out that a decision based on price may not necessarily be the same as a decision based on value.

Top secret stat Avoid a traffic minefield. Approximately one in every three road crashes involves a vehicle being driven for work purpose.
